CEF's **Teaching Children Effectively, Level 1** course is a practical learning experience designed

to equip students with basic skills and effective methods to evangelize children and immediately begin a neighborhood or public school outreach ministry. Emphasis is placed on organizing and conducting meaningful classroom activities which can enrich children spiritually. Students will be required to participate in teaching five children's classes applying the methods learned in the course. In addition, three student demonstration sessions will be conducted during the course to provide each student with evaluated experience in applying the theory taught.






## Praise Him, praise Him!
